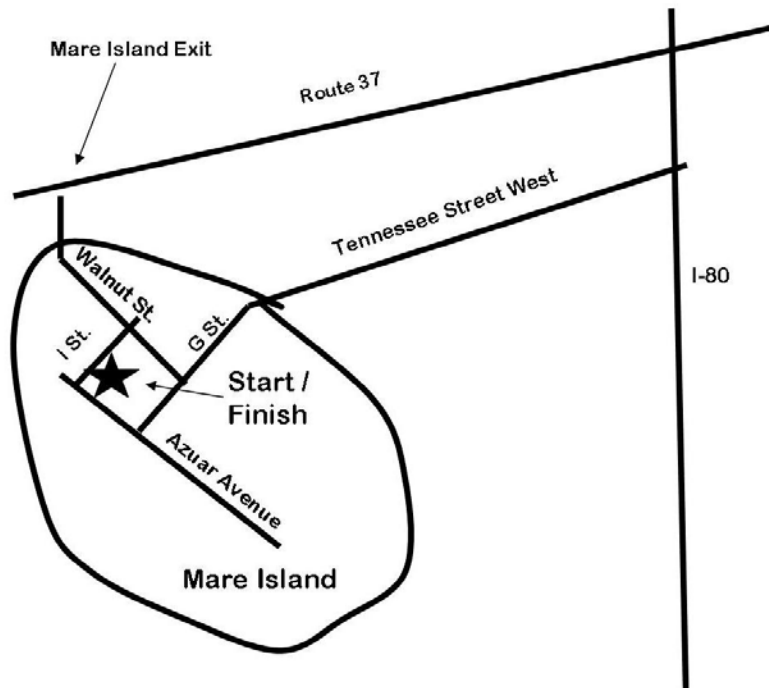


DIRECTIONS: From I-80, exit on Tennessee St. West. Tennessee becomes Mare Island Causeway, which becomes G Street after crossing the bridge to Mare Island. Turn right on Azuar Avenue.

From Highway 101, take Route 37 to Vallejo. Take the Mare Island exit, then straight ahead on Walnut to G. Turn right on G, then right on Azuar.

GENERAL: Volkswalks are noncompetitive walking events of five kilometers (3.1 miles) or longer. The routes of travel are through scenic and historic areas and are hosted by local clubs affiliated with the American Volkssport Association (AVA). Water and rest stops are usually available along the walk but it is also a good idea to carry water with you. Anyone can walk the course at no charge. All participants must register and turn in their registration cards at the end of the walk so they can be counted. The event is open to everyone. The event will take place in all weather conditions. No refunds.

STIPULATIONS: With registration for this event, the participant accepts the guidelines of the AVA and agrees to observe the principles of good sportsmanship and safety. Every participant must adhere to all directions of the control personnel. Littering is not permitted. Awards will not be sold outright.

FEES/PRE-REGISTRATION: Clubs/Organizations are encouraged to pre-register in writing as a group.

The route includes a self-guided nature trail through a wetlands area, new housing developments on Mare Island, the renovated homes of Officers' Row and the beautiful and unique St. Peter's chapel which has the largest collection of Tiffany glass windows under one roof.

AWARD: The award is a patch commemorating the event (see first page).

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: This walk qualifies for the following special programs: Walk the USA A-Z (V), Riverwalk America (Napa River), Islands (Mare Island).

MISCELLANEOUS: Water and restrooms will be available at the start/finish only. Please plan to carry water with you. Pets are not permitted on the trail. Strollers are OK. Wheelchairs are not OK due to lack of curb cuts in some sections.
